Seneschal:

The Kingdom Seneschal has asked if we might be able to still host Fall Crown due to site issues with the previously accepted bid from Blackwater. The Barony voted to continue support for the bid submitted by Baron Eric for the October 6th event at St Paul's Lutheran Church & School. We await final confirmation from Kingdom.

Exchequer:

Checking: \$5805.29 Savings: \$3975.55

1st & 2nd Quarter Reports completed & filed, as of 6/30/18 the Barony had a profit of \$850.67. Champs profit was \$326.84.

Post Event Report:

Pax Interuptus July 6-8th at Genesee Country Campground Steward: Andrew of Thescorre: the site owners Joe & Edy would like us to schedule next year's event asap, particularly if we want to reserve the hall or any cabins. Lunch Cook: Robert of Thescorre & Fawna with help from many other gentles. Tollner- Matilda: 221 adults on site, plus 26 children, 100 on board for lunch. The event had a profit of \$654.28. Youth fighting was awesome. There were no major issues.

College of Three Ravens for February 23rd 2019 at St Paul's Lutheran Church & School Event Steward: Gwen Cook (Jenn, mentored by Margurite), Feast Cook: Cairistian Symon (Mina), Lunch Cook: Katja (Chris), Tollner Marguerite, Class Coordinator: Nicole (Nikki), Rattan Co-ordinator: Corbin (Joel), Rapier Coordinator: Eric, A & S Coordinator: Torbjorn Sigardson (Jon)

Site cost \$1000, lunch \$800, feast \$800 (100 gentles). Registrations: Adult Event \$17, Member Discount Event \$12, Child Event \$6, Feast \$8. Estimated attendance= 200 gentles, breakeven point=150.

Facility amenities, restrictions and schedule all the same as last year with the addition of a treasure hunt.
