We have 7 classes registered so far. Her Royal Majesty will be elsewhere, but an invite will be going to Their Highnesses shortly.

Pax Interruptus (theme: The Good Olde Days) July 5-7th, 2019 at Genesee Country Camp-ground, Event Steward: Margurite de Neutchasteau, Tollner (needed), Lunch Cook: Andrew of Thescorre (lunch will be served to all attendees), Marshall in Charge: Corbinus de Cuvis, Archery Marshal: Gwen Cook. Fee Structure: Adult \$19, Adult Member \$14, youth \$7.

New Event Bid:

Baronial Champs, May 24-27th 2019 at Richard's Castle in Bergen, Event Steward: Lady Capt'n Nikki (and the Three Swans Crew) –This event would be a joint venture with the Barony of the Rhydderich Hael (pending their approval), sharing workload, profit and tournament fields for Champions activities. Reservationist Katja (& Caleb), Feast Cook: Richard of the Swamp (& Crew) feast limited to 75 (paid in advance). Other staff to be determined after R.Hael approves plan. Site cost \$400, food cost \$325, porta johns \$400, \$50 misc expenses = \$1175 total expense. Est attendance: 140. Fee Structure: \$5 day, \$10 weekend, children \$3, feast \$8 adult, \$5 child. Estimated income \$1345 = \$170 profit total. Comparable schedule to last year, but starting ½ hour later, features Heavy Combat, Fencing, Archery, Thrown Weapon, Bardic and A&S Champion Tournaments. Torbjorn is now a warranted TW marshal at large! Practice Sundays 2:30p to 4:30p at Athos's house on the east side –continuing until the butts freeze, have wood to make new stands for next season, west side practice at the castle, only through the end of October.

Arts & Sciences:

Otelia purchased supplies for award medallion painting at A&S Workshop night which was held October 9th and a second session will continue next month November 13th at Red Shield Hall (Wine & Beer tasting optional). December will be the traditional Yule, wear garb if

possible, bring a snack or beverage to share. Sadira held a Fun-with-Food workshop with folks making herb butter and herb vinegar, and cooked some harvested puffball mushrooms. Will be looking at Dec/Jan for next Fun-with-Food, topic to be announced.

We are registered for a demo booth at the Rochester Makers Fair Saturday November 17th at the Riverside Convention Center. Thescore Awards

Baron Eldjarn the Thoughtful

In response to our request for award recommendations, Dubheasa and I have been asked for a reminder of what the various Thescore awards entail. We gladly use this opportunity to share the information so everyone may have clarification. *

The Raven's Feather is given for service to the Barony. Examples of service to the Barony include but are not limited to: autocrating, kitchen work, tollner, setup or clean up at an event, field or court heraldry, holding an office, camp setup, sharing of the arts or sciences through cooking, teaching, or sharing of marshaling, teaching a martial art, provision or teaching of music or dance, and encouraging or assisting new members.

The Order of the Broche shall recognize accomplishments in the gentle arts within the Barony. Examples of the gentle arts include effort in cooking, brewing, sewing, needlework, lace-making, woodworking, dance, music, storytelling, metalworking, jewelry-making, spinning, weaving, etc.

The Order of the Black Talon shall recognize accomplishments in the martial arts within the Barony. Examples of the martial arts include effort in fighting, fencing, archery, thrown weapons, siege weaponry, and combat archery.

The Raven's Egg is given at the whim of the Baron and/or Baroness. It is a repeatable, non-precedence-bearing token presented by the Baron and/or Baroness. Recommendations for recipients of the award are to be given to the Baron and/or Baroness and may be made by anyone. (The official description of the Raven's Egg is extremely vague. It may be used to acknowledge anything from a single notable contribution by a gentle, to many individual acts that indicate a tendency that may not be sufficient for other awards.)

The Benefactor of the Barony is given at the discretion of the Baron and/or Baroness to non-Barony or non-SCA individuals for support of the Barony and its activities. Examples can include (but are not limited to) the owner of a site what has gone above and beyond in allowing the Barony to use that site for events. The Benefactor is a one-time, non-precedence bearing honor.

Award of Muninn – Given as a one-time, NON-precedence-bearing award in recognition of long-term dedication to the Barony. Award given at the pleasure of the Baronage based upon Their observations as well as recommendations from the populace.

‘Long-term dedication to the Barony’ is intended to mean deeds embodying the industriousness of Thescore for decades. Examples include - significant involvement in the shaping of Thescore for the better, relentless support & promotion of Thescore activities, constant

beneficial guidance for newcomers, copious service in various capacities such as Barony officer, autocrat, guildmaster/mistress, or ceaselessly volunteering with kitchen, troll, marshalling, teaching, etc., etc.

Award of Huginn – Given as a non-precedence bearing award in recognition of the individual exhibiting the most exceptional, consistent, courteous bearing to enhance the medieval ambience and pageantry of local SCA activity. Given at the pleasure of the Baronage based upon Their observations as well as recommendations of the populace.
Examples of courteous bearing include - proper use of titles, respectful gestures, kind speech & behavior, polite conduct, good manners, etc.

Please note that while recipients are mostly residents of the Barony, these recommendations may include individuals who do not reside within our borders, but who have frequently contributed to the Barony or our populace.

This Baronage interprets the Broche and Talon use of the term ‘accomplishment’ to be some combination of notable skill and/or exceptional support of a discipline via teaching, marshaling, encouragement, or otherwise helping particular activities to occur.

There is abundant parking off-street in the site's parking lot. The entire site is handicap-accessible, and the event is located on the ground level.

With this year's College of Three Ravens comes an invitation to journey into the Seafarer's Academy and explore myths and legends of the seas all while attending classes, engaging in martial activities, feasting on delicious dishes, and engaging with one another. No alcohol is permitted at the facility. Enclosed flame is allowed. Service animals are welcome (proof of current vaccinations required). Sneakers must be brought (not worn) into the gym by all combatants to help protect the wooden floors. Smoking is only allowed outside, well away from entryways.

Directions:

Take your best route to NYS Thruway (I-90) – exit onto I-490 towards Rochester.

Exit onto I-390 northbound for 7.9 miles.

Use the left lane to take exit 27B onto the Lake Ontario State Parkway westbound.

In 3.2 miles, take East Manitou Road exit, turning left at end of off ramp.

In 0.8 miles, turn right onto Frisbee Hill Road.

In 0.6 miles, turn right onto North Greece Road.

In 256 feet, turn left onto Frisbee Hill Road.

Continue straight as Frisbee Hill Road becomes Wilder Road, which in turn becomes East Avenue.

After a total of 2.9 miles you will arrive at the school (on your right).
