Meta badge= SCA Achievement, sub badges include: Volunteering (pins=retaining, setup/takedown, cooking), Arts & Science (pins=scribal, historical research, teaching), Combat (pins=heavy, fencing, archery), Camping (pins= outdoor/emergency first aid, outdoor living/survival, tents & shelter).

Directions:

Take your best route to NYS Thruway (I-90) – exit onto I-490 towards Rochester.

Exit onto I-390 northbound for 7.9 miles.

Use the left lane to take exit 27B onto the Lake Ontario State Parkway westbound.

In 3.2 miles, take East Manitou Road exit, turning left at end of off ramp.

In 0.8 miles, turn right onto Frisbee Hill Road.

In 0.6 miles, turn right onto North Greece Road.

In 256 feet, turn left onto Frisbee Hill Road.

Continue straight as Frisbee Hill Road becomes Wilder Road, which in turn becomes East Avenue.

After a total of 2.9 miles you will arrive at the school (on your right).
