Ragnar inn raudi (Carter) - I believe that this youth has traveled the most in the last year. Facing opponents in Delftwood, Hartstone, The Hael, and BMDL. He will fight until the fighting ends and then ask for more. He has served as Kingdom Youth Champion for division two.

Take your best route to NYS Thruway (I-90) – exit onto I-490 towards Rochester.

Exit onto I-390 northbound for 7.9 miles.

Use the left lane to take exit 27B onto the Lake Ontario State Parkway westbound.

In 3.2 miles, take East Manitou Road exit, turning left at end of off ramp.

In 0.8 miles, turn right onto Frisbee Hill Road.

In 0.6 miles, turn right onto North Greece Road.

In 256 feet, turn left onto Frisbee Hill Road.

Continue straight as Frisbee Hill Road becomes Wilder Road, which in turn becomes East Avenue.

After a total of 2.9 miles you will arrive at the school (on your right).
