#### **Officer Reports:**

**Exchequer:** \$6113.75 in checking, \$4054.62 in savings. Year end report finished there was a profit of \$728.77.

**Heavy Fighting:** Athos reporting. Thursday nights starting at 7 PM ending at 9 PM, although it is occasionally earlier or later than those times. Generally 5 to 8 attending with a good night seeing 10 fighters.

**Archery:** Gwen Reporting. Archery is on hiatus. Loaner gear available. Corbin is seeing to new gear needs.
