Court Report for College of Three Ravens, February 26 A.S. XLV (2011)

Their Avian Excellencies Aquila and Bronwyn, 7th Baron and Baroness of Thescorre opened Their court.

Their Excellencies called the Autocrats of the event, Elzbieta and Torsten, into Their Presence. Thank yous and gifts were presented to the event staff for their excellent and dedicated work in making the day a success.

Lord Eldjarn the Thoughtful, Chancellor of Classes was called before Their Excellencies and asked to speak. He thanked all the teachers for donating their time and willingness to share their knowledge with others. He asked that the names of all teachers be read aloud, and it was noted that a large portion of the room was standing when the last name was read. Lord Eldjarn let all teachers know that they would receive a small token of appreciation from him after court.

Lord Eldjarn was asked to return to Their Excellencies Presence in his role as Captain of Archers. He awarded tokens to the following gentles: Kadlin Sigvaldakona, Thomas of Petersham, T.W. They both confirmed this. Baron Eric then formally recognized him as his Cadets before the entire Court.

Curia Report
Barony of Thescorre
February 15, 2011

Officer reports (in no particular order):

Seneschal: December report submitted. Countess Branwyn has been named as the Baronial Chatelaine.

Exchequer: The Barony has \$2,775.16 in the checking account and \$3,483.22 in the savings account. Since the last curia, I have completed the 4th quarter report which shows a net loss of \$748.91.

Knight Marshal: Heavy weapons practice continues on Thursday evenings at the Adams St Rec Center. Average attendance has been about 4-5 fighters.

We have enough loaner armor to outfit 2 people, plus a few more pieces to supplement if necessary. I am working on repairing the remainder to hopefully have a 3rd full suit of loaner armor. The Barony has 4 serviceable loaner shields and 1 loaner sword. Again, I am working on making loaner weapons to outfit 3 people.

I have been asked to be Marshal in Charge for Pax Interruptus and Baronial Champions.

I am currently trying to get more of our group to be marshals as well.

Thrown Weapons Marshal: It's been cold. Due to the cold, our butts are frozen. Therefore, we have not been throwing sharp things at our butts for fear of having the sharp things return to sender rather suddenly. Besides, no one likes cold butts, so we stay inside to keep warm. When the cold goes away, we will likely move our butts back outside, and proceed to perforate them vigorously.

Fencing Marshal: Fencing Marshal -- Regular practice is ongoing, with attendance of from 2 to 7.

Archery Marshal: Activity unchanged. Outdoor practice at RIT on hiatus for the season. Plans for unofficial indoor/winter challenge gatherings suspended due to health issues.

Heraldry: Since last curia there is not much to report. One gentle has requested a consultation on a name, but we have not had a chance to meet and discuss yet. I plan to work on updating the OP for the Baronial level awards over the next several weeks. It would be helpful if any gentles who have business for court at C3R also touch base with me, as well as Their Excellencies, so that we can start setting up the docket.

Minister of Lists: Nothing to report.

Chronicler: The Fewmet has been coming out monthly.

Web Minister: The baronial website is online and paid through 9/1/2011.

I have been updating it with the usual stream of regnum changes, calendar updates, newsletter uploads, event announcements, and email forwarding management.

I have begun development on a web application with the intention of eventually replacing the static HTML site with an interactive collaborative online hub for the Barony. This effort is still in early stages.

Minister of Arts & Sciences: March A&S will be a reprise of C3R; April will be a slide show tour of French castles. She needs a deputy.

Steward: Same song, different verse...

We have stuff. It lives in the basement. We have other stuff that lives in the garage.

At some point in the relatively near future it would be good to do a sort, toss, count and organize project with the baronial kitchen.

Current Status

- *All Fewmets, AEstels, and Pikestaffs currently in my possession have been sorted and are being scanned into digital form-this is on hiatus due to my working on my classes for C3R and will resume again next month.
- *I have received some files (hard copy) from Phillippe and have received them as digital files from Daedra.
- *As soon as health allows, I will be getting together with some of the longer standing members of the Barony to go through some of their files and digitize what may be of interest to others.

Goals For the Coming Year

- *I will be digitizing as much as possible so that as we lose hard copies, there will be a backup digital file.
- *I plan to start with pictures once I have the text files completed. I need to look into what, if any, paperwork is involved when using pictures in a digital medium. From the sound of the Kingdom Chronicler, it seems like online is okay without paperwork so long as you remove items if you have been asked. But I will ask before I move forward.
- *I would like to create a site that can be linked to from the Thescore site so that anyone can access the files whenever they'd like. This will be a little while in coming, as it will happen once I have enough files to begin.
- *It has been requested that I create a "scrapbook" of the photos and files that currently exist. This will be a bit of an undertaking and will probably take longer than the year, but I plan to begin on this once the digitizing is complete.
- *After looking at some of the files that I have access to, I have decided that it might be nice to have some "interest group" file sections. I would like to start with recipes. We have many great cooks in the Barony, many of which make cookbooks for every feast they cook. It would be nice not to lose the recipes. I have access to cookbooks from as long ago as the 1980's and would like to create a group of files pertaining to this topic. If there are other topics people would like researched, I would be more than happy to look into putting together "special interest" file groups for those topics as well.

Questions

- *Does anyone have anything that they would like to contribute to the files? I would be more

than happy to make appointments to come to you or you may make an appointment to drop files off with me.

*Does Steffan want to have his pictures put into the database? I can go through the Thescore group files to find them if that is the case.

*Which court reports would people like kept track of? Kingdom or just Baronial?

Chatelaine: In my month as Chatelaine, we have gained two new Barony members, Gwyneth and her son. Gwyneth was in the SCA in the past, and has recently moved here and rejoined us. She is interested in becoming a part of the new ADEPT group.

On that topic, I have organized a new ADEPT group, which consists of myself, Sigvaldi and Dubheasa, Thomas of Petersham, Fridrikr and Orianna. Others are more than welcome to join as they have time and inclination. The idea is to have a group of people who are used to each other and any alternate persona they may have for demos only, so that when we have ADEPT demos, we are ready to present them as well as possible.

We do have one demo coming up in April for a homeschool group in Genesee County. They will be reserving a park for the demo, which will be either on the 9th or the 16th of April. I would like to present a few different areas: an ADEPT set up, a fencing and/or fighting area, a dance area, and one other, which could be calligraphy or fiber arts or something else, depending on who is able to make it. I'd like this to be a pretty amazing demo, since this lady has been trying to put this together for awhile and running into dead ends.

Gold Key: Nothing to report.

Their Excellencies reported on various events that They had attended and that They are looking forward to College of 3 Ravens.

College of 3 Ravens: Lots of classes. Approximately 70 preregistrations; 80 is the limit. All seems to be going well.

Event bids:

Baronial Champs – Bid presented by Sigvaldi; date is May 27-29th, site is the Home of Tom & Diane Smith in Hemlock. Cost is \$6 for adults, \$5 for 5-17, under 5 free; sideboard lunch and pie potluck for dinner. Usual activities planned. Camping is available for the weekend for anyone interested. Bid was approved.

Pax – Bid presented by Alison; date is July 8-10; site is the Genesee Country Campground. Deposit of \$200 due April 1st. Moving to the back of the golf course which will give us more privacy and get us out of the way of the campers. \$6 for adults, \$3 for children; \$4 per night camping. No feast so we won't be using the dining hall. Perhaps lunch will be served on the field.

The 7 Pearls Thrown Weapons tournament will be help. Bid was approved.

Pennsic: Mick has preregistered the Barony of Thescore as a group and is willing to be the Land Agent for the Barony again this year.

Branwyn mentioned that she is looking to purchase copies of the new Known World Handbook for the Chatelaine's office.

Nikki asked about updating the Domesday book. It was suggested she speak to Eldjarn about it.
