Court Report of Their Avian Excellencies, Aquila d'Athos and Bronwyn nic Gregor, 7th Baron and Baroness of Thescore, held in the Presence of Their Highnesses Khalek and Branwyn at Thescore Baronial Championships, 26 May, AS 47 (2012) at Schloss von Tannenacker.

Their Excellencies called before them Lord Edmund of Worcester who informed the Court that Lord Padraig Ua Céileachair had donated a bow to the Archers of Thescore that had previously belonged to The Honorable Lord Ulric Wulfricsson. Lord Edmund presented the bow to their Excellencies with the recommendation that it be kept as Baronial Regalia for the Thescore Archery Champion. Their Excellencies did decree that this shall be so.

Baron Athos spoke for Lord Donald Harefoot who was unable to be present in court with report of the Heavy tournament completed this day. Peter of Thescore was named Rattan Champion of Thescore. Scroll by Lady Mairghread ui Stilbhard uu Coinn.

Their Excellencies spoke for Baron Eric Grenier de Labarre who was unable to be present this day to announce that the Baronial Rapier tournament was completed on at rapier practice on Monday this past week and that Lord Leslie of Fairferd had won the tournament and has been named Rapier Champion of Thescorre. Scroll by Lady Mairghread ui Stilbhard uu Coinn.

Their Excellencies called Lord Edmund of Worcester before them to report on the Thrown Weapons tournament completed this day. Gabriel of Thescorre was announced winner of the competition and was named Thrown Weapons Champion. Scroll by Lady Mairghread ui Stilbhard uu Coinn.

Howard did make it known that he had business before The Court. He did present to Their Excellencies a missive from Lord Nicholas of Dartmoor which was read to those assembled. Lord Nicholas apologized for his prolonged absence, and announced his intent to return to Thescorre before the Great War.

The Khanate Buran of the Dark Horde Moritu proclaimed their desire to enter court peacefully and presented gifts of friendship to Their Excellencies including a vambrace and a needle woven belt.

Their Excellencies called Lord Richard von Tanner before them and acknowledged the hard work that he put in to ensure a successful event. Lord Richard was presented with a Raven's Egg with Their thanks.

**Excerpts from the Court at Crown Tournament,
with all the pertinent information about
Thescorrians recognized that day included**

As reported by Maistir Brandubh Ó Donnghaile at the Court of Their Sylvan Majesties Andreas and Kallista, King and Queen of Aethelmearc at Their Crown Tournament held on the fifth day of May anno societatis xxxvii in the Barony of Delftwood with the attendance of Their Heirs Khalek and Branwen, Prince and Princess of Aethelmearc, and Their Excellencies Edward and Anastasie, Baron and Baroness of Delftwood, in attendance.

PAX INTERRUPTUS XXXVI

As the Winter winds recede and Spring comes upon us we invite the populace to think about preparing your camping set up, and to participate in Martial activities at the 36th Pax Interruptus in the Barony of Thescore. Pax will be held July 6 - 8, 2012, at Genesee Country Campground, 40 Flint Hill Rd., Caledonia, NY 14423. The site opens at 2 pm Friday and closes at 1 pm Sunday. Saturday activities will include melees for heavy fighters and fencers, and for archery and thrown weapons. Baron Aquila and Baroness Bronwyn will hold Their Baronial Court. We will be providing a light Sideboard lunch in the afternoon but no feast. Please plan accordingly. The site has a camp store for some groceries, ice and wood, as well as flush toilets and showers. The site is discreetly damp. Camping will be around the edge of the main activity area. The field as before, does not have immediately available water so plan to bring some. Dogs are permitted on leash with proof of license and vaccinations which must be presented when you troll in, and must be cleaned up after please! Campers will be provided with a trash bag and should plan to carry it out to the dumpster near the camp store as they leave. Day visitors are encouraged to bring pavilions for shade. There will be porta johns on the edge of the field. Merchants may set up a booth. Sunday morning the Campground will be serving a breakfast in the dining pavilion for \$4.00 per adult, \$2 per child.

Costs for the event are Site fee \$8 per adult, \$4 for Children ages 6 to 15. Children 5 and under free. Camping for Adults \$4 per night. Camping for Children \$2 per night. We would encourage those camping to pre-reg so we may be better able to accommodate everyone. A non-member surcharge of \$5 for those without proof of membership, will be collected at the door. Please make checks payable to SCA NY, Inc, Barony of Thescore.

Directions: From Rochester: Take I-490 West to Exit 1, LeRoy, then follow the signs to Rt. 19 South to LeRoy. Approximately 4.5 miles, turn left onto Rt. 5 East at the light in LeRoy. Go east on Rt. 5 about 4.1 miles and watch for the sign for the Lime Rock Speedway and Genesee Country Campground on the left. Turn left onto Flint Hill Road. Approximately .5 miles on the left will be the campground. Turn into the main campground entrance marked with the SCA sign. SCA signs will be posted.

Directions: From the East, West, or Southwest, take your best route to the New York State Thruway and exit 47, Rochester/LeRoy. After the toll booths, take I-490 East toward Rochester and exit at Exit 1 (your first exit off 490). Follow the signs to Rt. 19 South to LeRoy. Approximately 4.5 miles, turn left onto Rt. 5 East at the light in LeRoy. Go east on Rt. 5 about 4.1 miles and watch for the sign for the Lime Rock Speedway and Genesee Country Campground on the left. Turn left onto Flint Hill Road. Approximately .5 miles on the left will be the campground. Turn into the main campground entrance marked with the SCA sign.

From the Southeast, take I-390 north to Exit 10, Avon. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Rts. 5 & 20 West. Follow 5 & 20 West through the village of Avon (follow the signs around the traffic circle and stay on 5 & 20). Just outside of Avon at a blinking light, Rt. 20 splits off Rt. 5. Stay to the right on Rt. 5 West. Follow Rt. 5 West through the village of Caledonia and around the traffic circle. Follow Rt. 5 West. After you cross the railroad tracks, go about 1.3 miles to the sign for the Lime Rock Speedway and Genesee County Museum on your right. Turn right onto Flint Hill Road. Approximately .5 miles on the left will be the campground. Turn into the main campground entrance marked with the SCA sign. SCA signs will be posted.
