Court Report of Their Avian Excellencies, Aquila d'Athos and Bronwyn nic Gregor, 7th Baron and Baroness of Thescorre, 7 July, AS 47, at Pax Interruptus XXXVI.On the field in the afternoon:

Lord Edmund of Worcester presented Their Excellencies with those archers who have advanced in rank. His Excellency Aquila d'Athos achieved the rank of Archer. Saoirse of Thescorre and William Eldjarnson were recognized for achieving the rank of Marksman.

Lord Edmund also announced the winner of the day's archery competition. His Honorable Lord Milhim ibn Rashid was presented with a scroll acknowledging his achievement. Scroll calligraphed by the hand of Mistress Matilda Bosville de Bella Aqua and illuminated by Lord Edmund of Worcester.

Their Excellencies requested the presence of Lord Sigvaldi inn enski to report on the status of the throwers of Thescorre. Lord Sigvaldi recognized Gabriel of Thescorre and Jared of Thescorre for each achieving the rank of Caster.

Mistress Irene von Schmetterling did request to approach the court and presented Their Excellencies with an artifact of the days of Thescorre gone by. Their Excellencies did accept this artifact and promised to pass it on to the baronial Historian.

At evening court:

Their Excellencies thanked the day's autocrat, Mistress Alison of the Many Isles, for her hard work preparing for a running this event.

Their Excellencies thanked Lord Richard von Tanne and THL Timothy of Edgewood for their assistance in engineering portable pole holders to be used this day and in the future.

They then called forth the Order of the Black Talon and inducted him into that order, recognizing his martial prowess upon the field of battle. Scroll by Her Highness Branwyn ferch Gwythyr.

Their Excellencies did request that the members of the Order of the Black Talon remain to induct one more into their number. Lord Edmund of Worcester was then called forth and inducted into the order in recognition for his achievements with bow and axe. Scroll by Lady Mairghread ui Stilbhard uu Coinn.

The Court of Their Excellencies was then Closed.

the Report of the Court of Their Sylvan Majesties Andreas and
Kallista, King and Queen of Aethelmearc, held at Pax Interruptus
on the seventh day of July anno societatis forty-seven in the Barony
of Thescorre, Their Sylvan Highnesses Khalek and Branwyn,
Prince and Princess of Aethelmearc, and Their Excellencies Aquila
and Bronwyn, Baron and Baroness of Thescorre, in attendance.**

... Master Toki Redbeard of the East rose and demanded to be heard. He spoke to Their Majesties that he had sent petition of his lawsuit against Master Fridrikr Tomasson av Knusslig Hamn, and Their Majesties had appointed this day to hear all arguments and testimony, and to give Their fair judgment of the lawsuit in this fifth court assembly. Their Majesties answered that before all these witnesses They would hear the case, and give judgment, and that it would be a fair judgment. Their Majesties then called Master Fridrikr Tomasson av Knusslig Hamn to present himself. They spoke to him that the Order of the Laurel had raised a lawsuit against him that he had insulted them by shunning their assemblies and failing to wear the marks of the order. Master Tofi Kerthjalfadsson further spoke that Master Fridrikr was his student and before he could speak his defense in court he must be released from fealty to stand alone by his reputation a free man. Baron Devon explained that over the winter months the original hound of the Sylvan pack of Aethelmearc, Dilligaff the wonder pup, had passed away. This new saddened Their Majesties and so they determined that the ranks of the Sylvan Pack of Hounds must be bolstered and so they inducted the hounds The Grimm Nicolai Ekaterinavich and Khuren Nohkoi into the Sylvan Pack...

... Their Majesties demanded the presence of Lady Nezhah bint Saleem, as They had been counseled by Their orders. They had heard much of Lady Nezhah's skill at Middle Eastern dance and had eaten her cooking, and called forth the Order of the Fleur d'Aethelmearc so that they could welcome her into their ranks. Scroll by Mistress Deadez of the Hord Moritu, framed by Master Devon Adair Bartholomy...

... Lord Eldjarn the Thoughtful was brought forth and inducted into the Order of the Golden Alce. For ten years he had served as an archer, acting as marshal, Baronial archery champion and Captain of Archers through that time, repairing and maintaining the Baronial loaner equipment. Scroll in progress by Her Highness Branwyn ferch Gwythyr...

... Mistress Orianna Fridrikskona was invite forward as it was noted that 20 years ago at Pax Interruptus she had been elevated to the Order of the Pelican, and Their Majesties presented her with that scroll, still in progress by Master Morien ap Rhys and Mistress Matilda Bosville de Bella Acqua...

... Master Fridrikr Tomasson av Knusslig Hamn was called forth. Fridrikr spoke to all assem-

assembled that he would call witnesses and prosecute his case against the Order of the Laurel. As they had made a lawsuit against him for failing to attend the assemblies of the Order of the Laurel and failing to wear the emblems of the Order. Fridrikr spoke that as he was not a member of the Order of the Laurel, he had not right to attend their assemblies and wear their regalia, and so he counter sued the Order of the Laurel for insulting him and bringing forth a false lawsuit against him and asked Their Majesties outlaw the members of the Order of the Laurel. Their Majesties replied that They would hear the testimony of his witnesses, and then give Their Judgement. Fridrikr called Duchess Rowan de la Garrison, Duchess Meirwen uerch Owein, Duke Frederick of Holland words read by Lord Finn Folhare, Sir Haakon Oaktall, Mistress Daedra McBeth a Gryphon, Mistress Margana bro Morganwyg words read by THLady Emer nic Aidan, Master Tofi Kerthjalfadsson and Master Toki Redbeard. After presenting his evidence, Fridrikr awaited the response from the Order of the Laurel. Their Majesties replied that it would not be required for the Order of the Laurel to respond with witnesses, as They had heard all that They needed to give Their judgement on this matter. They asked if Fridrikr and the order of the Laurel would now accept the judgement that Their Majesties gave. Both parties replied that they would accept whatever judgment that Their Majesties would give in this matter. Their Majesties then gave Their lawful judgment. As the lawsuit of the Order of the Laurel stated that Fridrikr is worthy to wear the regalia of the order, the order will not be outlawed, but Fridrikr will be inducted into the Order of the Laurel. Because the Order of the Laurel falsely accused Fridrikr with failing to attend assemblies, the order must pay a fine to Fridrikr, or any present may pay on their behalf. The fine shall be one ell of scarlet, a wreath of Laurel, three ounces of silver and food and drink. Fridrikr was given a cloak of scarlet, a laurel wreath placed upon his head, Master Tofi Kerthjalfadsson produced a silver broach in the form of a laurel wreath that satisfied the silver, Master Cynwyl MacDaire presented the ancestral fruitcake, and Viscount Haakon Oaktall presented Fridrikr with a drinking horn. Their Majesties then accepted Fridrikr's oath of service as his acceptance of admission into the Order of the Laurel and acceptance of the judgment and all fines being paid. As reported by Maistir Brandubh Ó Donnghaile, Silver Buccle, at the Court of Their Sylvan Majesties Andreas and Kallista, King and Queen of Aethelmarc, held at Pax Interruptus on the seventh day of July anno societatis forty-seven in the Barony of Thescorre, Their Sylvan Highnesses Khalek and Branwyn, Prince and Princess of Aethelmarc, and Their Excellencies Aquila and Bronwyn, Baron and Baroness of Thescorre, in attendance.

Court Report of Their Avian Excellencies, Aquila d'Athos and Bronwyn nic Gregor, 7th Baron and Baroness of Thescorre, 6 August, AS 47 (2012) at The Pennsic War.

Their Excellencies requested the presence of Lady Otelia d'Alsace and thanked her for her generous donation to the cause of the redesign of the gate into the Baronial encampment. Lady Otelia was gifted with a Raven's Egg with Their thanks.

Their Excellencies did request the presence of those members of the Order of the Raven's Feather. They then inducted Lord Edmund of Worcester into the order in recognition of his service to the Barony. Scroll by Lady Mairghread ui Stilbhard uu Coinn.

Their Excellencies invited those members of the Order of the Black Talon present to enter the Court. They then requested the presence of Lady Octavia of Thescorre and inducted her into the order of the Black Talon in recognition of her achievements in heavy fighting. The Order was then instructed to greet their newest member. Scroll by Lady Kaðlín Sigvaldakona.
