**Minutes of the Barony meeting January 17, 2012****Lady Genevotte opened her first Barony business meeting!****Officer reports:**

Minister of Arts & Sciences: Adren: Arts & sciences in the Barony is moving along; have many barony members teaching at College of 3 Ravens and the MoAS is very grateful. Start thinking about IceDragon – the rubrics and categories are posted; please check the web site ( ) and enter! Dancers are dancing, scribes are scribing, threadworkers are working on a more regular meeting time and location. (post meeting note – Alison is looking to book her church for February 25<sup>th</sup>; Isabella is looking to book her community center for April 28). Cook's Guild is meeting regularly at Daedra's.

Web Minister: Eric – Changed the email forwarding for the new officers; menus for College of 3 Ravens are posted on the event information site.

Fewmet: Pdraig – newsletter is coming out; always need articles (perhaps on what you learned at College of 3 Ravens?).

Fencing: Padriag – due to the holidays, only one practice recently but it was a well attended practice.

Gold Key – Niki: nothing new; one outfit still outstanding from Pax.

Herald – Elzbieta: has acquired the herald's box and poked it, but will not look at it in detail until after C3R. Still needs to send her info to Silver Buckle Herald.

Archery – Edmund (via Elzbieta): archery equipment is safely living in the basement. Arrows have all been stripped and are awaiting reconstruction. One 40lb right hand bow appears to be delaminating and not sure if it can be repaired.

Chatelaine – Branwyn: have been meaning to set up a newcomers night; would like to do it every 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month. Currently waiting on response back from site otherwise may be looking for alternatives. Also, would like to purchase a copy of the new edition of the Known World Handbook for the demo box. Requested \$25.00 for the purchase, which was approved by the Barony. Has also been in email contact with one new member.

Knight Marshal – Khalek: Fight practice has resumed, Thursday nights at the Adams Street Rec Center. Looking to find a site for a regional practice.

Their Excellencies – Aquila & Bronwyn: there is an event coming up and there will be a court. We have a lot of business but we will try to keep the court short. May be attending the Deadlie Carnival event in Delftwood and then Ice Dragon.

Exchequer – Alina: (who is slowly recovering her voice...): \$3273.40 in the checking account, \$3488.01 in the savings account. Finished the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2011 report and the Barony made a profit of \$203.47. Called M&T Bank to confirm that they received the paperwork from Milpitas for the new bank account. She has received the new signature cards. Ask that all outstanding checks please be cashed ASAP so the checking account can be closed as soon after C3R as possible. Will be closing the savings account and moving to the new account. Keeping the checking account open until C3R is complete.

College of 3 Ravens – Eric: College of 3 Ravens is less than 3 weeks away. The reservation clerk (Dubheasa) is accepting reservations. The class schedule is available (and is full, although Orianna is waiting on final details on 2 classes). Feast preparation sessions have started – one last weekend at Katja's, one this coming weekend at Elzbieta's plus more the week before the event. Eric is planning to open the site at 6am Saturday for setup (since due to a church activity we cannot get in to do setup Friday evening). Any help with unloading kitchen stuff and food, and moving chairs and tables will be very helpful.

Seneschal – Genevotte:

We have a bid for Baronial Champs: Richard is autocrat, Niki is assistant co-autocrat; Date May 26-28; location is Richard's land in Bergen, which includes plenty of land for the various champion activities, camping, bardic circle, and houses a shower and flush toilet (plus other goodies). Site cost is \$150, fees will be \$5 for adults, \$4 for children. Bryn is tentatively signed up to make lunch; still need a pie coordinator for dinner. Dubheasa will be the tollner. Barony approved the bid.

We also have a bid for Pax: Alison is the autocrat; date July 6-8; location Genesee Country Campground. Nezhah will be doing the lunch. Orianna is the tollner. Site cost is going up to accommodate one more porta-john (to general cheers from those assembled) so we will be renting 2 regular and 2 handicapped porta-johns with potential of having them cleaned partway through the event if necessary. Prices will be the same as last year but based on last year's success Alison is upping the estimated attendance numbers to 225. Barony approved the bid.

Curia is the February business meeting. One topic from the last curia is on the docket – adding exchequer approval to the selection of the tollner/reservation clerk for events. Genevotte read the proposed wording and asked folks to think about it. Additional item is adding the web minister to the officer list and officer rotation schedule (proposed July even years). An additional suggestion was made about adding something to the policies about the ceremonial transfer of offices being done in Baronial court but the general consensus seemed to be that this was not necessary (and some office changes may not align with a Baronial event).

Orianna requested \$20 to purchase an additional file box for the Seneschal's office, as the current 2 are too full to contain any more files. Expense approved.

Classes will begin at 10:00am and continue until 4:00pm. The site is handicapped accessible and has ample parking.

The adult site fee of \$7 includes a sideboard lunch (children under eighteen - \$4, children under 5 - free.) A family cap of \$22 for the \*site fees only\* will be in effect. A \$5 non-member surcharge must be collected at the door for adults without proof of membership. The site is Dry, no alcohol permitted. Enclosed flames are allowed, open flames are not. Nut-based products of all kinds are forbidden on site (due to student's life-threatening allergies).

The sideboard lunch will be prepared by Baroness Katja Davidova Orlova Khazarina (Chris Adler-France). The middle-eastern feast will be prepared by Lady Elzbieta Tradienyte (Emily Bald). Adult feast is \$8, (children under eighteen - \$4, children under five - free). Feast seating is limited to 100. From the East: Get off I-90 at Exit 45 (Victor) and get onto I-490 West. After eleven miles, take Exit 21 onto I-590 North. Go 0.9 miles on I-590N and take Exit 7 onto Browncroft Blvd. Follow the directions below.

From the West: Get off I-90 at Exit 46 (Scottsville) and get onto I-390 North. After five miles, take Exit 15 onto I-590 North. Go six miles on I-590N and take Exit 7 onto Browncroft Blvd. Follow the directions below.

From the south: Get off I-390 North at Exit 15 (Downtown Rochester) onto I-590 North. Go six miles on I-590N and take Exit 7 onto Browncroft Blvd. Follow the directions below.
