The College will take place at the United Methodist Church of North Chili, located at 2200 Westside Drive Rochester, NY 14624. The site will open at 9:00am and close at 10:00pm. Those present after 9:00 pm may be pressed into clean-up duties! Classes will begin at 10:00am and continue until 4:00pm. The site is handi-capped accessible and has ample parking.

**Fun Display and Fundraiser Reminder**

Greetings, good gentles---

I'd like to take this opportunity to remind everyone that Barony of Thescorre's annual College of Three Ravens will play host to a fundraiser for Rochester's local Easter Seals New York Diagnostic and Treatment Center. In order to attract donations, the theme of our fundraiser is "The Middle Ages: A Tactile Experience". The reason for this is that many Easter Seals clients have particular reason to enjoy the world through their sense of touch. In service to assembling an exciting display, I hope to provide a wide range of items for passers-by to enjoy. Therefore, I invite all who receive this missive to consider lending a contribution to be placed upon the table.

Do you possess an especially well and interestingly worked wooden item? Do you have something made of metal? How about different fabric examples that one can touch and compare? What about raw materials? Items may be smooth, rough, texturally patterned, soft... These are just some ideas. Be creative! \* I do ask, however, that any items offered be safe and sturdy enough for even a child to handle all parts without having to look (being considerate of those with vision issues) and then to be able to handle food afterwards without unusual cause for concern.\* (The point of this is not to require that everything be sterile, of course. It's just to acknowledge that kids sometimes rub their eyes or put their fingers in their mouths before their parents can catch them at it. Therefore, please be mindful of toxicity. A "reasonable parent" standard is all that's being asked here.) I also ask that each item be labeled clearly on a 3x5 index card for content, just as the ingredients of any food item would be in a tasting display, in case any gentle needs to be forewarned of potential allergens or other aspects that could possibly be irritating to a particular individual. In this way, I hope to be able to include items such as wool without having to risk the well-being of anyone wishing to enjoy the experience. The table will be attended at all times, so anyone unable to read a notecard can ask what information is provided thereon. Objects that are fragile, sharp or otherwise potentially hazardous, or that may shed in some manner or otherwise easily create a mess will not be needed and would best be left for use in other contexts.

If you would like to participate by offering one or more items for the day's display, it will work best if you contact me directly, either by replying to this message or by sending a new message to carlo at thescore dot org, as soon as you are able. It is my intention to have as many firm advance commitments regarding display items as possible, so I can plan properly for space on the table. However, there is still plenty of time for you to consider what you'd enjoy presenting. Furthermore, if, for some reason, you aren't able to confirm with me before the day of the event, please bring your item anyway, and I'll be happy to do my best to make a place for it. If there is any question as to the appropriateness of any particular item you'd like to share for the day, I'll do my best to address the issue. Please just let me know. All items are expected to be collected by their owners before the close of the event.

Thank you, everyone, for your kind consideration and generosity. I'm thrilled to have the privilege of coordinating this effort. Please distribute word widely, cross-posting to other lists when possible, so as to broaden the scope of our display and provide opportunity for participation as much as possible. I look forward to hearing from you!
