April 2016 Business Meeting notes:

Seneschal- there is a change to SCA policy regarding the fee structure wording of event announcements. Going forward you will begin to see “Event Registration” or “Adult Event Registration” for non-members, and “Membership Event Registration” or “Adult Member Discount Registration” for card carrying SCA members –Member Registrations will always be \$5 less than the regular Adult Registration. Youth Registrations will be *at least* \$5 less than the regular Adult Registration, whether their parent is a paid member or not. Per Thescore custom this means: Youth Registration for ages 5-17 = Adult Registration, minus \$5, divide by 2. We are a participant based Society. If you are present at an event, you are a participant, not a spectator. Future Event Stewards are reminded that they need to send their Event Announcements to the Seneschal for review *prior* to submitting to the Kingdom Calendar.

Exchequer- we have money, Checking balance \$3565.98, Savings balance \$3847.46; updated signature cards are on file with the bank so Matilda can now sign checks. The Exchequer has updated Tollner sheets which reflect change in wording of event fee structure, they will be available after she gets done tweeking them. First Quarter Financial Report completed.

Event: Baronial Champs May 27-29 (Event Steward not present) -please note there is NO LUNCH, Event Registration has been adjusted accordingly. Announcement is on both Kingdom & Barony web pages.

Event: Pax Interupus July 8-10 will be a Royal Progress event, Duchess Branwyn will be tollner & MOL and will need the assistance of several other tollners during the weekend; various marshals have been lined up but additional help may be needed; Khalek is running a Torchlight Heavy Weapon Tourney Friday night.

Event Proposal: Njal Saga October 14-15, 2017 (yes, 18 months away) event bid presented by Baron Fridrikr; Event Steward of the Day: Elen Woderose; site: 4H Camp Bristol Hills: hall, kitchen, 4 cabins (sleep 60-80 guests); All Day Lunch cook (no feast): Cauldron Bleu & friends; Tollner: Baroness Orianna; A "Theatrical Reading" (immersion event) of an edited version of Njals Saga (mostly in English, some Old Icelandic) aprox 6 hour performance with intermissions, all day sideboard. Barony provides the hall, kitchen & tollner staff; Performance cast & crew (aprox 30 people) take care of the rest. Alcohol strictly prohibited. Cold breakfast Sat&Sun. Site cost \$1250, food \$600, misc \$500 (total cost \$2350); Member Discounted Admission \$16 (or maybe \$18), Overnight accommodations per person \$7.50/night. Based on 100 event participants and 60 overnight guests x2 nights= \$150 profit. With significant advertising to SCA Viking/Icelandic interest communities, expect to pull in participants from surrounding Kingdoms. Event proposal seconded and approved with no objections.

Barony Picnic August 27 @ Richard's Castle (only date available to Her Excellency) –Nikki will be in charge. Usual Pot Luck, usual garb/not garb, usual activities & schmoozing. Barony will provide Hots/Hamburgers, rolls, condiments & paper goods, the rest is up to you.

Marshal activities: Heavy weapons is picking up and soon to move to outdoor practices at Highland Park (Vietnam Vets Memorial/South Ave). Fencers had their first outdoor practice this week, may start a 2nd weekly practice *later this spring in conjunction with the heavy fighters on Thursdays at the park. *Thrown weapons still on hiatus. We will have both Heavy weapons and fencing melees, archery and thrown weapons during Saturday to show the martial prowess of our Kingdom, and a revelry at night will complete the celebrations for The King and Queen and our Baroness. In addition, a torchlight tourney will be held on Friday evening at dusk. Hosted by His Grace Khalek.

Open flames are also allowed, and fires can be built in the designated areas of the campground. Please be advised that fires are permitted only within existing fire rings. This site is discreetly damp. The field and camping area do not have water; plan to bring enough to meet your needs. Dogs are permitted on leash with proof of license and vaccinations, to be presented upon check-in, and must be cleaned up after. Trash shall be disposed of in the dumpster by the camp store upon leaving; bins for recycling are also available.

Camping is available both Friday and Saturday nights. We will have space for tents with ample port-a-castles scattered throughout, as well as room for RV camping with hookups. The site offers a limited number of cabins up by the camp store, within an easy walk of full bathroom facilities. Merchants are welcome at no additional charge, but must bring their own setup. Day visitors are encouraged to bring their own pavilions for shade.
