Barony of Thescorre Business Meeting June 21

(reported by Mistress Matilda)

Seneschal:

- The following offices are up for renewal July 1: Steward, Fencing Marshal, Throw Weapons Marshal. (no applications were received, current officers continue by default)
- College of 3 Ravens bids are due at the August Business meeting.
- Lord Eldjarn has submitted a proposal to change Baronial Policy with regard to adding 2 new Baronial orders, wording has been sent to the Thescorre e-list and will be discussed at the July Curia meeting.

Exchequer:

- we had \$3127.38 in checking and \$3848.10 savings at the start of the meeting. (Checks for upcoming event expenses were issued)
- the Event Report for Baronial Champs is complete, we lost \$188.60 on the event due to several factors including low attendance
- reimbursement was issued to Genevieve for the web site renewal

Upcoming Event: Pax Interruptus will be held July 8,9,10 at Genessee County Campground, Marguite says the site tokens are done, the hand out is in progress, volunteer sign up sheets went around for Friday set-up (3pm-dusk), Tollner Friday/Saturday, and site clean up Sunday 8am-noon. Everyone must be off site by noon.

- The Barony is hosting a Yard Sale Fundraiser for the Scribes of Aethelmearc, which Mistress Roberts has volunteered to take charge of. Bring your donations to PAX, also plan to return & collect any items that do not sell.
- Lunch is by reservation only

Marshal Activities:

- Heavy Weapons meets Thursdays at Highland Park, they have been picking up a few new people
- Fencing takes place Mondays at Adams Street Rec Center
- Archery happens at Richard's Castle when Marshals from the Hael are willing/able to attend, watch for announcements on the List & Facebook, thus far attendance by Thescorrians has been low
- Thrown Weapons has practiced a couple times on Sundays @2:30, again watch the List for announcements.

- Barony will not participate in the Palmyra Parade this year due to conflict with Summer's End in the Hael & lack of available volunteers

The Baroness:

- seeking volunteers to Guard the Kingdom Gate Monday of War week -a sign up sheet went around and support was positive enough for us to take on the full day of slots.
- Her Excellency is seeking requests from those of the Barony who would like the Baronial Presence to accompany them to the fields for various battles, etc
- Reminder that the Event Workshops we are holding are intended for everyone's benefit, not just those who plan to autocrate in the near future.

Gold Key:

- discussion of issue regarding problem of getting loaned out clothes returned to the Barony Gold Key following an event. Result: Barony supports the idea of requiring a \$20 cash deposit from borrowers, to be held by Gold Key and refunded upon return of loaned items. If items are not returned & borrower unresponsive to communication, deposit becomes a donation to the Barony to replace lost items.

Policy Proposal – New Order(s)

Unto the Barony of Thescorre from your Seneschal Mistress Matilda Bosvyle, the following Policy Change has been proposed by Lord Eldjarn the Thoughtful for your consideration. We will be discussing and voting on this proposal at our July Curia Meeting (7/19), please read it carefully and come prepared to voice your opinion on the matter.

Policy Proposal – New Order(s) – June 2016

Part 1 - (Based upon Aethelmearc's Award of Augmentation)

6.4 Baronial 'order of devotion' (Name to be submitted to College of Heraldry as Order of Memory) – Given as a one-time, precedence-bearing award in recognition of long-term dedication to the Barony. Award given at the pleasure of the Baronage based upon nominations from the populace and recommendations of the Order. This is a polling order.

6.41 Long-term dedication to the Barony is intended to mean deeds embodying the industriousness of Thescorre for decades. Examples include significant involvement in the shaping of Thescorre for the better, relentless support & promotion of Thescorre activities, constant beneficial guidance for newcomers, copious service in various capacities such as Barony officer, autocrat, guildmaster/mistress, or ceaselessly volunteering with kitchen, troll, marshalling, teaching, etc., etc.

6.42 Recipients may wear the badge of the order. [Description of badge here - when accepted]

Part 2 - (Based upon Aethelmearc's Order of the Cornelian implemented similar to the Jewel of Aethelmearc, but as a Champion of Courtesy)

6.5 Baronial 'award of courtesy' (Name to be submitted to College of Heraldry as Order of Thought) – Given once a year as a non-precedence bearing award in recognition of the individual exhibiting the most exceptional, consistent courteous bearing to enhance the medieval ambience and pageantry of local SCA activity. Given at the pleasure of the Baronage based upon their own observations and recommendations of the populace. This is a non-polling order.

6.51 Examples of courteous bearing include proper use of titles, respectful gestures, kind speech & behavior, polite conduct, good manners, etc.

6.52 The newest recipient wears the symbolic medallion of the Order to stand as an inspirational example of courtesy until it is passed on at the naming of the subsequent recipient. Recipients may wear the badge of the order. [Description of badge here - when accepted]

Pax

As the war drums call is echoing across our land, The Barony of Thescore invite any and all warriors to join together to prepare for battle at our annual Pax Interruptus. July 8-10, 2016. For the last few days of Peace before War.

The site opens at 3 pm on Friday and closes at noon on Sunday. Genesee Country Campground 40 Flint Hill Rd, Caledonia N.Y. 14423

We will have both Heavy weapons and fencing melees, archery and thrown weapons during Saturday to show the martial prowess of our Kingdom, and a revelry at night will complete the celebrations for The King and Queen and our Baroness. In addition, a torchlight tourney will be held on Friday evening at dusk. Hosted by His Grace Khalek.

Open flames are also allowed, and fires can be built in the designated areas of the campground. Please be advised that fires are permitted only within existing fire rings. This site is discreetly damp. The field and camping area do not have water; plan to bring enough to meet your needs. Dogs are permitted on leash with proof of license and vaccinations, to be presented upon check-in, and must be cleaned up after. Trash shall be disposed of in the dumpster by the camp store upon leaving; bins for recycling are also available.

Camping is available both Friday and Saturday nights. We will have space for tents with ample port-a-castles scattered throughout, as well as room for RV camping with hookups. The site offers a limited number of cabins up by the camp store, within an easy walk of full bathroom facilities. RV camping and cabins cost a separate fee, both to be reserved with the site 1-585-538-4200, or <http://www.geneseecountrycampground.com>. Merchants are welcome at no additional charge, but must bring their own setup. Day visitors are encouraged to bring their own pavilions for shade.

Directions: From Rochester: Take I-490 West to Exit 1, LeRoy, then follow the signs to Rt. 19 South to LeRoy Approximately 4.5 miles, turn left onto Rt. 5 East at the light in LeRoy. Go east on Rt. 5 about 4.1 miles and watch for the sign for the Lime Rock Speedway and Genesee Country Campground on the left. Turn left onto Flint Hill Road. From the East, West, or South, take your best route to the New York State Thruway and exit 47, Rochester/LeRoy. After the toll booths, take I-490 East toward Rochester and exit at Exit 1 (your first exit off 490). Follow the signs to Rt. 19 South to LeRoy. Approximately 4.5 miles, turn left onto Rt. 5 East at the light in LeRoy. Go east on Rt. 5 about 4.1 miles and watch for the sign for the Lime Rock Speedway and Genesee Country Campground on the left. Turn left onto Flint Hill Road. See *below. *Approximately .5 miles on the left will be the campground. Go past the main campground entrance and turn into the entrance marked with the SCA sign. Follow the markers to the Tollner.

From the East, West, or South, take your best route to the New York State Thruway and exit 47, Rochester/LeRoy. This is only a rough idea of when events will be happening for PAX, of course all this is on SCA time. Please be advised that the field and camping area do not have water. Remember to plan on bringing enough to meet your needs. There will be Gotts at all fields of drinking water.

Dogs are allowed but must be on leash and with proof of license and up to date vaccinations must be presented upon check-in, and they must be cleaned up after. All trash can be disposed of in the dumpster by the camp store upon leaving and there are bins for recycling available. Lunches are per-paid only and limited to 100. at this time there are still lunches available.
