Coronation of Timothy and Gabrielle April 22, 2017, the Barony approved the modified bid at the social meeting Nov 1 due to site change to Zion Episcopal Church in Palmyra, the site fee was later lowered after consultation with the Kingdom Exchequer Event Stewards: Orianna Fridrikskona & Elisabetta de Venetia, Tollner Fridrikr Tomasson, Cook Andrew of Thescorre. *post meeting update* our bid was accepted by the Kingdom!

- Scriptorium: meeting regularly; prepping scrolls for A&S Champs, Fall Academy, and Baronial scrolls for Baronial events Mairghread, Genevotte, and Abigail participated in the French Quilt all day immersion workshop in October and Mistress Roberta is teaching at it. Mairghread is also participated in the White Vine All Day workshop at Fall Academy and is teaching a class on making a scroll using period materials and methods. Mistress Roberta assisted at the White Vine class as well. Mistress Roberta has been holding scribal playtimes at events including Coronation and Heralds and Scribes.
- Threadworkers guild - Meeting regularly and teaming with Cauldron Blue for some meetings.
- Middle Eastern Dance and Drumming – meeting regularly
- Cauldron Blue – Cooks Guild report: Meetings have resumed led by Mistress Katja and some teaming with Threadworkers is occurring; Inventory at Steffan's house was cleaned and reduced and funds were requested to purchase replacement storage bins. Cook's Guild cashed the \$100 check I received from the last barony business meeting and purchased the six storage containers requested for the kitchen equipment. Policy Proposal for 2 new Baronial Awards passed.

Policy Proposal – New Awards(s) – October 2016

Part 1 - (Based upon Aethelmearc's Award of Augmentation)

6.4 Award of Muninn – Given as a one-time, NON-precedence-bearing award in recognition of long-term dedication to the Barony. Award given at the pleasure of the Baronage based upon Their observations as well as recommendations from the populace.

6.41 'Long-term dedication to the Barony' is intended to mean deeds embodying the industriousness of Thescorre for decades. Examples include - significant involvement in the shaping of Thescorre for the better, relentless support & promotion of Thescorre activities, constant beneficial guidance for newcomers, copious service in various capacities such as Barony officer, autocrat, guildmaster/mistress, or ceaselessly

volunteering with kitchen, troll, marshalling, teaching, etc., etc.

6.42 Recipients may wear the insignia of the award (badge, token, etc.). [Description of badge here – when created]

Part 2 - (Based upon AEthelmearc's Order of the Cornelian implemented as a Champion of Courtesy)

6.5 Award of Huginn – Given as a non-precedence bearing award in recognition of the individual exhibiting the most exceptional, consistent, courteous bearing to enhance the medieval ambience and pageantry of local SCA activity. Given at the pleasure of the Baronage based upon Their observations as well as recommendations of the populace.

6.51 Examples of courteous bearing include - proper use of titles, respectful gestures, kind speech & behavior, polite conduct, good manners, etc.

6.52 The newest recipient may wear the chosen regalia to stand as an inspirational example of courtesy until the accoutrement is passed on at the naming of a subsequent recipient.
